**SB2049/HB2421 CRIMINAL LAW: Missing citizen alert program.**

**Summary:** Encourages the TBI to develop an activation card for law enforcement use in connection with the missing citizen alert program to help locate missing citizens who have wandered due to dementia or physical impairment. Allows law enforcement agencies to seek assistance from nonprofit organizations.

**Amendment Summary:** Senate Judiciary Committee Amendment 1 (013578) deletes Section 1 of the bill and rewrites the section to (1) require local law enforcement agencies to develop area-specific protocols for implementation and (2) require TBI to develop the cards similar to the Amber Alert Activation Card.
